

GEOMETRICAL RIDDLES

How to Play:

- 1.** For some questions you will need a stopwatch, a pad of paper, and a pencil. Decide before starting the game if players will be allowed to use a calculator. We recommend not using them.
- 2.** Place all the cards in a pile, question-side up.
- 3.** Player 1 takes the top card (without letting anyone see the answer side) and asks the player on his/her left the question (Player 2). If the question is answered correctly, Player 2 wins the card.

If not, Player 1 reads the answer aloud and puts the card into a discard pile.

4. Player 2 now takes the top card from the pile and asks the next player the question.
5. Play continues in a clockwise direction until all cards have been asked. The player with the most cards at the end of the game is the winner.

Optional Short Play:

Rather than playing all 54 cards, decide before beginning how many rounds you want to play.
